The possibility that large number of patients with cancer worldwide are taking citric acid orally is very high

The theory that citric acid (citrate) would be effective as a cancer treatment was published in Medical Hypotheses since March, 2007 (Bucay, 2007); then, the first patient with cancer, medullary thyroid cancer, who improved while taking citric acid orally as his only treatment appeared in the same journal in May 2009 (Bucay, 2009); and there is a second case report of a patient with terminal cancer, peritoneal mesothelioma, which also improved only with the treatment of oral citric acid (Bucay, 2011). All this information is very easily found in internet, and, citric acid is very easy to find and buy, so, the possibility that a large number of patients with cancer are taking citric acid orally, without telling this to their doctors, is very high. The evidence of this possibility is already published (Bucay, 2012).

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
